FACTS:

- EPRM runs twice each year
- The programme is spread over **14 weeks**
- Coursework and assignments to support a strong **research proposal**
- Five modules offered online and in-person
- Online **tutor-led** sessions



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EPRM trains participants in:

- Translating policy issues into research questions
- Preparing a research proposal
- Analysing qualitative and / or quantitative data
- Designing, writing and disseminating proposals for evidence-based research, either in the workplace or in a broader research environment
